# Opening of the 16th General Assembly

Heleen welcomes everyone to the 16th General Assembly (GA) of the AUCSA.

### Sequential ordering of the agenda

Heleen goes through the agenda of the GA, which for this GA is made up of only the Elections of the position for Secretary. Heleen asks whether someone wants to vote on the agenda. NO one wants to vote on the agenda, and the agenda is thus accepted.

#### **Elections**

#### **Personal Statements**

Heleen asks if there are any questions, which there are not.

Heleen then welcomes Adel Sochat to the stage to hold her personal statement. After Adel finishes her personal statement, Heleen asks the GA if there are any questions.

Florentine asks Adel what her first priority would be. Adel answers: Approachability is key and I want to increase transparency. Letting the members of AUCSA know what the AUCSA is up to and that they know that the AUCSA board is here for the members.

## **Voting**

Heleen asks the members per table to come up to Florentine and Anna to get their voting ballots. Florentine makes sure the proxies get their voting ballots, and Anna checks the names of the ones voting. Once all the votes have been collected, the election committee, together with one member go and count the votes.

#### **New Board Results**

When the votes have been counted, the election committee comes back to the GA, and Ascha from the election committee and Advisory council reads out the votes. Ascha announces that the Secretary of the Board of 2014-2015 will be Esther Baar. The votes can be collected with Florentine. The total number of votes was 81, with 56 for Esther Baar and Adel had 25 votes. Heleen thanks the Election committee for their hard work, and Adel for running.
