



LETTER OF THE AUDIT COMMITTEE

Amsterdam, May 7, 2014

Dear AUCSA member.

Through this letter the Audit Committee would like to inform you of the outcome of the half-yearly audit of the AUCSA financial records. Here is a short recap: the Audit Committee is charged with checking whether the AUCSA Board manages its finances well. We were very happy to see that the Treasurer's administration has started to use new financial software that makes the bookkeeping process more efficient. Nevertheless, we would like to make some recommendations to further improve the financial records.

Firstly, we would like to advice to keep the records more organized. The treasurer was able to explain every of our questions, however, the archive needs ordering and labelling. At the same time, the archive needs to be further updated to show the current state of affairs. We suggest that the AUCSA treasurer order his archive based on the transaction number. Also the column "memo" in the financial software should be used more consistently.

Secondly, we still find AUCSA to be underspending. This is a chronic issue, for which we would like to recommend three solutions. One is that at the start of the year AUCSA overbudgets, because if money is not spent, overbudgeting provides an alternative to spend it on. Another solution would be to include personal proposals of students in the first budget GA to spend the money on. Students could propose to spend the money on items that could be used in and around the academic building, such as a football table or table tennis table. Another possibility is to spend it on equipment that is available to all committees for usage, such as a speaker system or an AUCSA car! A third solution would be to hold frequent meetings with the treasurers of the committees to see how the money is flowing.

Lastly, we propose to have fixed dates for the Audit committee to check the AUCSA records. We propose start of January and end of June for reasons of consistency, but also continuity within the Audit committee. The newly established Audit committee will do the June check this year, but the members from this year will help them in conducting the Audit.

Evaluation: Goals and Progress

Looking back on this past year, welcoming around 250 new members, and 9 new committees, the year has been good. In the beginning, the Board set goals to ensure that indeed, this year the AUCSA would fare well. Our focus was on making sure that the students felt the urge to organise events themselves, and to create the right circumstances for this, and therefore we aimed to:

- increase visibility, and to improve the connection with the members. Previous Boards have already added to the visibility of the AUCSA, and we wanted to build on this foundation and make sure every student knows what the AUCSA is and what we do. Besides that, we wanted to have a more personal connection with our members, so that they felt that they could approach us with their ideas and questions.
- to help the committees thrive, promote and stimulate student involvement in committees and events. Our vision was that the AUCSA is its committees and teams, and they are the cores of what happens in the association. Therefore we wanted to make sure they would have the facilities and opportunities to do what they wanted. We also wanted to make sure new ideas and student initiative would have a place to grow, so a special focus on stimulating students to form committees or teams was very important to us.
- lastly, we thought that a good relationship with our committees would ensure they felt that we were there to help them, and would facilitate a good working relationship. We strived to have personal connections with the committee boards and their members, which turned out to indeed help our relationships with the committees and was a lot of fun!

Our first big event was the Introduction week and weekend where the AUCSA Board, and the papas and mamas, welcomed the class of 2014! We worked hard throughout the summer to organise the social part of the introduction week, and a weekend where we would go to Limburg to get to know the new students. We enjoyed, among other events, a potluck dinner at the dorms, the crazy 44, a bike tour through Amsterdam Oost, and the awards night where we discovered the class of 2014 has a lot of talented students! A special thanks to our papas and mamas, and of course the new class for making the week incredible. Of course, this was only the first part of the fun, as we departed on Friday to go to the introduction weekend location. A lot of the new students appreciated the time they got to bond with their fellow first years, and papas and mamas, on the weekend where they



could lie in the sun, do some sports and dance the night away in the evening. Slightly tired, but satisfied, we left for home again on Sunday where their real first AUC year would start.

During this AUCSA year, we have had quite some General Assemblies, partially due to the Board changes, where we had to say goodbye to Barend and Rose, and welcome Helio and Anna to the team. Besides that, we have had our massive budget GA, where the entire budget of the AUCSA was allocated in a whopping 3.5 hours, and we were ready to go from that. The four election GAs were we welcomed both Anna and Helio, and the new AUCSA Board (part of it), Lia Sinnige, Jan Willem Bruggeman, Henriette Hoogervorst, Eoin Grua, and eventually, at the 16th GA, Esther Baar. Fortunately we saw an amazing rise in GA attendance, though we would still love to see all our members join us to make these important decisions.

In October, together with our loved colleagues of the AUC Student Council Board, we officially presented our Boards to AUC faculty, the management, and other sister Boards at our constitution drinks. We enjoyed nice speeches, presents and good conversations with the guests. Some unknown perpetrator managed to steal Quomy The Deer back from the management, and up until today we deny all involvement.

Women's week was the great success of one of our teams. The focus was on issues concerning women and persistent inequality felt by them, but also the great value of gender equality was emphasized. They organised a week full of interesting activities, from a self-defense workshop and a lecture about sex workers, to the icing on the cake with the Vagina monologues and the boobie bible! In the end, they managed to raise €2315,58, and it was donated to the Blijf Groep to support women in need. This money is now used to, among other things, organise a running club for women, which AUC women can join!

With the winter break near we all got together to have the winter formal, together with the AUC staff, to enjoy some nice drinks and performances in collaboration with TAC, On Stage, Performing Arts, and Solace. The evening looked glamorous with lights and everyone dressed in Great Gatsby style, thank you everyone for looking amazing!

This year has been amazing considering the rise of the amount of committees! Not only did we welcome many new committees, we are also proud of our committees for doing so well this year, old and new ones. Sadly we had to say goodbye to Garden, though we could welcome the 10



incredible new committees! TEDxAUCollege, Zen, Curiosity, Junket, Pubquiz, AUC Lingua, AUC Literary Society, PlayUC, AUCafé, and AUCMAC have added to our own diversity of student interest. To thank all committees, the AUCSA Board organised Happy Boards Day, with a pubquiz and (quite) some dancing at our beloved Polder.

As we all know, AUC can be tough at times, especially during finals, and we wanted to support our members and give them a small moment of distraction and some goodies. The goodie bags were very much wanted – as indicated by the line in front of the office – and provided the students with some fruit, energy, a nice mantra and more to help them get through the last exams and essays.

This year, the UCSRN (University College Student Representation of the Netherlands) organised some really nice inter-UC events, the Deans Debate in Middelburg, and the Inter-UC tournament in Utrecht, together with three summits at UCM, LUC, and AUC. The collaboration has been very fruitful for us, and has given us the opportunity to learn from the other Boards and UCs. Sadly we came in second (again) at the Inter-UC tournament, but we will try again next year!

In June, as a closing AUCSA event of the year, Dorm Fest was held in June. Great performances of our own talent and other bands could be seen, and many activities were to be enjoyed. The Dorm Fest team didn't hold back this year and went full on with the underwater world theme, with amazing decorations and paintings by our artistic members. Great food, great cocktails, a fashion show, and much more made the day one to remember.

At the end of the year, we said goodbye to the class of 2014, with the graduation ceremony and an amazing end of the year party organised by Solace in Odeon. The class of 2014 has contributed enormously to the growth of the AUCSA and we wish them well in their adventures after AUC! The Amsterdam University College Alumni Association will welcome them to the growing pool of AUC alumni, making sure they keep in touch with us.

All of our committees have done amazing work, but one achievement of one of our committees should be highlighted. The enthusiastic AUCafé Board managed to arrange, set up, and start the first AUC student bar! With weeks of preparations and writing documents, they managed to organise not only this, but also an agreement with Jeugdland to offer AUC students in order to help with the children that come there as a community project, in return for us being able to use their clubhouse as our bar. They have worked incredibly hard, and were at times almost better prepared than us,



and we are so proud of them for achieving this and we hope that many generations of AUC students can enjoy a nice beer at Jeugdland as the fruitful collaboration continues.

Our time has come to an end, and even though you will probably see us around, it is time to hand over the responsibilities to the new Board members who have new energy and ideas to run the association. 





ASUSA is the Amsterdam Sustainability Association, our environmental committee. This year ASUSA had a Top of the Week up on the LCD screens every week, projecting a tip concerning sustainability or other environmental matters on the screens in the AUC building, on the MyAUC website and on Facebook. They worked on making the canteen more sustainable in reducing the amount of paper cups used, with the aim to get students to bring their own cups to be filled, but the canteen owner Eurest did not want to cooperate. ASUSA introduced the wonderful Plastic Bag Cycle in the dorms, improving the system that was set up last year. 
AUCAFÉ






INPRINT




PLAYUC






INTROWEEK & INTROWEEKEND
